

A **webinar** is a live online workshop. Sometimes webinars are interactive. Often the presenter will take questions at the end.

Attendees register ahead of time and will receive an email with a link to join.

Many webinars are recorded as an **archive**. You can view archived webinars when convenient for your schedule. Archives also allow viewers to pause and replay sections for better understanding.

Webinars are available from a variety of organizations, and cover many different **topics** including financial resources, behavior, transition to adulthood, social skills, and new research findings.
